The successful revitalization and rebranding of the former Corbin Heights community in New Britain, Connecticut, was the culmination of a public-private partnership that transformed a blighted World War II era housing project into a modern and welcoming residential neighborhood.

## Industria Commons

The former Corbin Heights was a densely packed public housing development made up of over 400 residential units arranged in more than 50 drab and mundane masonry buildings.

A comprehensive redevelopment resulted in 235 modern apartment homes in a transformed community newly branded as Industria Commons.

## Development Challenges

- ◆ Negative public perception and stigma associated with former community
- ◆ Active community and resident support necessary to assemble public financing
- ◆ Community and unit designs to accommodate mobility issues and allow residents to *age in place*
- ◆ Intricate construction phasing required to minimize resident disruption and relocation
- ◆ Safety paramount during demolition and construction activities in an occupied residential neighborhood
